Raymonde Uy is the Physician Informaticist with the National Association of Community Health Centers (NACHC). He is a scientific reviewer for the American Medical Informatics Association (AMIA) & the International Medical Informatics Association (IMIA), as well as an assessor for the Text Retrieval Conference (TREC), an NIST and U.S. DoD partnership contributing to efforts in clinical information retrieval (IR), clinical decision support (CDS) and precision medicine.
